## A Little History....



- 1989: HB 2187 requires that all publicly funded colleges and universities to adopt, evaluate, and report on an undergraduate core curriculum.
- 1997: SB 147 requires the THECB to adopt rules that include a "statement of the content, component areas, and objectives of the core curriculum" which each institution is to fulfill by its own selection of specific courses.

### 2003: Texas Administrative Code Chapter 4, Subsection B, Rule 4.28



- At least 42 lower-division semester credit hours requirement
- The core component areas must satisfy the "exemplary educational objectives"
- The core must be consistent with the Texas Common Course Numbering System and must be consistent with the embedded charts.
- "core complete" transfers to all Texas public institution of higher ed.
