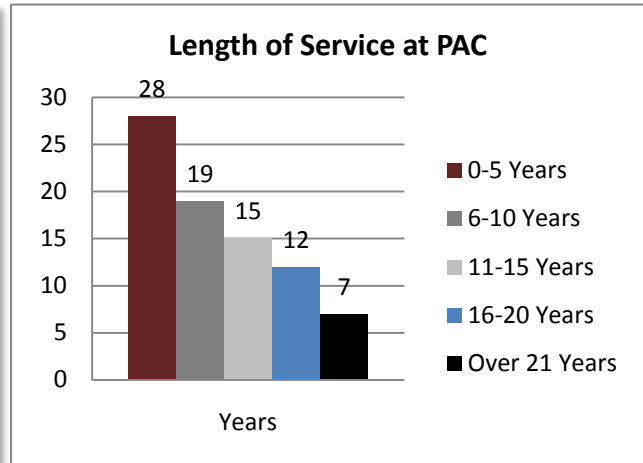
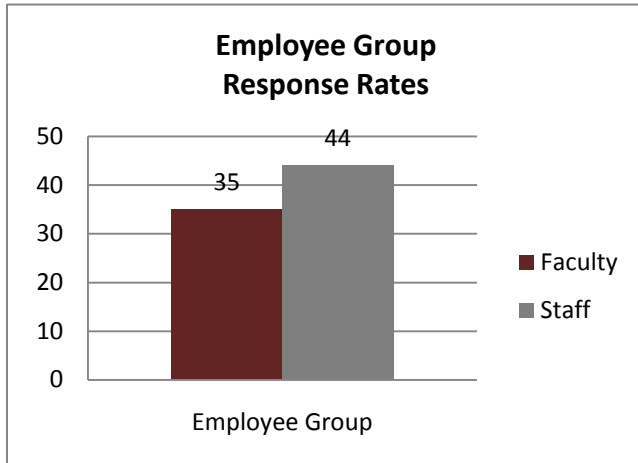


Employee Development Day 2009

Survey Results

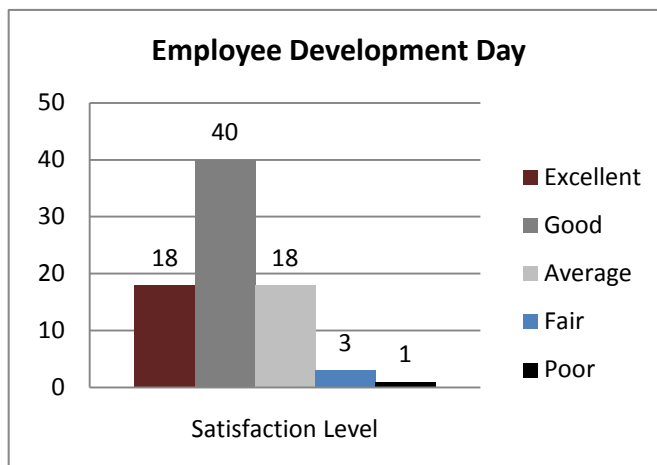

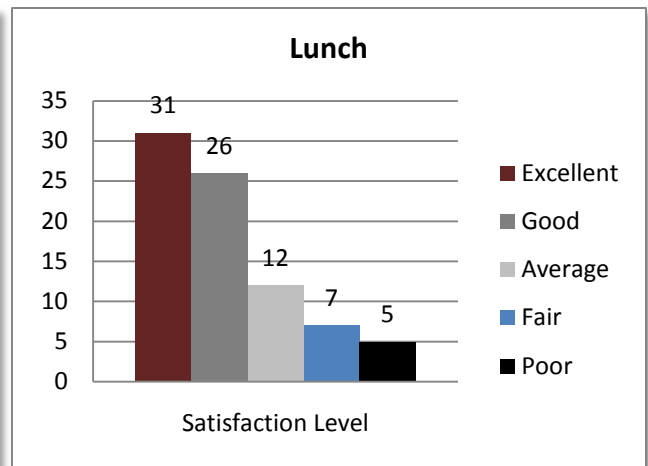
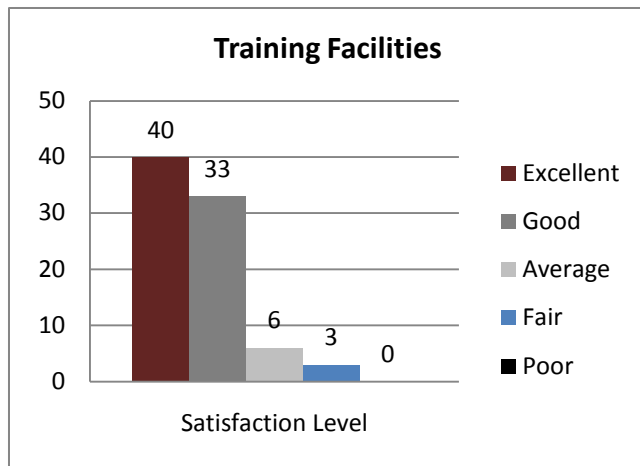
