	Findings 90% of assessed students in Spring 2011 LMGT 1340 Contemporary Logistics Issues scored 78% or higher on the final exam case study, that challenged students to demonstrate and understanding of management's role in the process of logistics.
	Related Action Plans Plans are to provide videos weekly on instructional topics that will augment the teaching model on-line and in the classroom.

	Achievement Target for this Measure 70 % of Student make a "C" or better on the LMGT 1323 Domestic and International Transportation Management final exam case study.
	Findings 100% of the students in Spring 2011 LMGT 1323 Domestic and International Transportation Management made a "C" or better on the final exam case study relating to supply chain management and physical distribution systems.
	Related Action Plans Bringing adjuncts with a strong background in transportation will help solidify this area.
