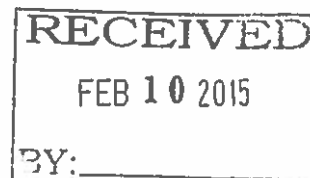

Northwest Vista College, Palo Alto College, San Antonio College and St. Philip's College are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges to award certificates and associate degrees. Northeast Lakeview College was granted candidacy status in June 2016 and a final site visit was conducted in Spring 2017, by SACSCOC.

Effective Fall 2016 students under the 2016-2017 catalog and forward will no longer have an identified major for an AA or AS degree program. Students under a catalog prior to Fall 2016 will still have an identified major. All other degree and certificate programs will continue to reflect a major.

Effective January 30, 2017 ACCD will no longer issue a single transcript that includes courses taken at all of the colleges of the ACCD. Instead, transcripts will be issued for each of the colleges attended in ACCD – Northeast Lakeview College, Northwest Vista College, Palo Alto College, San Antonio College, and/or St. Phillip's College.

QUALITY POINTS

The GPA is derived by dividing the total number of quality points by the total number of semester credit hours attempted (not including W, WM, WS, WX, IP, CR, NC, NR, AU) for which grades have been received. Once a course is repeated, the highest grade earned will be the one recorded in the GPA. If the same grade is earned, then the oldest grade is included.

Students may withdraw from a class up until 80% of a semester or session. Courses attempted are listed on the transcript by term. Developmental Education courses may earn an IP as a permanent grade.

EQUIVALENT TRANSFER CREDIT – Credit accepted from other institutions is shown with the number of semester hours accepted from each institution.

COURSE INFORMATION – The first digit identifies the level of the course ('0' signifies Developmental Education courses. '1' signifies freshman level course and '2' signifies sophomore level courses.) The second digit indicates the number of semester hours the course is worth and the last two digits identify the course sequence.

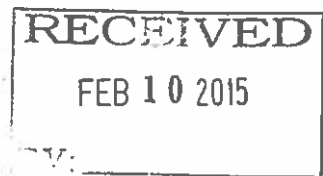

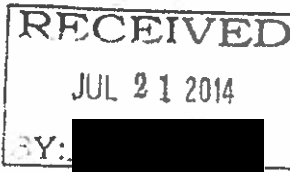

Unit of Credit

Effective August 1998, Georgia Regents University officially changed from the quarter calendar to the semester calendar. Each of the two semesters in the regular session covers a period of approximately 16 weeks, which include 15 weeks of instruction. The semester hour is the unit of credit in any course. It represents a recitation period of one fifty-minute period a week for a semester. A course meeting 150 minutes a week would thus give credit of 3 hours when completed satisfactorily. For credit purposes, 2 to 3 lab or activity hours are usually counted as the equivalent of one recitation class period.

A student may not receive additional hours of credit if s/he repeats a course in which s/he has already earned credit.

There are two grade point average computations used at Georgia Regents University. These computations produce a student's Institutional GPA and Regent's GPA. The Regent's GPA is used to measure the quality of a student's entire performance while at Georgia Regents University. The Regent's GPA is used for calculating honors and awards to measure the ability to take overloads, and as a basis for measuring continued eligibility for scholarships. The Regent's GPA is computed by dividing the total number of hours attempted that count in a GPA at Georgia Regents University into the total number of quality points earned on those hours.
