2. an *ACD GPA* that includes courses taken at all of the colleges within the Alamo Colleges District, and
3. an *Overall GPA* that is inclusive of all courses taken to date at any of the colleges of the Alamo Colleges District in which a student received a performance grade of A-D, F. Additionally, Earned Hours includes total ACD hours, as well as non-ACD hours accepted as equivalent transfer coursework.

The *Institutional GPA* and *ACD GPA* are calculated and appear for both the term and overall to date. The description of each GPA is listed in the lower left-hand corner of the transcript.
